I pray that you Australians might bear him to, as the Lord leads you! I desire others to write him, if the Lord gives you faith and puts anything on your heart. In very fact, I desire you brethren in America and Australia to have whole night prayer meetings for Him, Lord willing! God can turn Him, don't limit the holy one of Israel! Let us use the privilege we have to supplicate before an Almighty King, Who is more holy than men and more merciful too! If you do have a burden, saints, I ask you to please run it by me or at least a preacher or an elder, so we can all stay together in the burden of forbearing long with him, and keep a unified front, not giving an uncertain sound. Remember a little folly can destroy him that is in reputation for wisdom and honour (Ecc. 10:1). May God keep us all in the Spirit, wise concerning them that are without, wise as serpents and harmless as doves. I believe the Lord recently put a word of vision on my heart, BTW, for pursuing him, namely, "By long forbearing is a prince persuaded..." (Pro. 25:15) O Lord Jesus, give us success to persuade him and save this fallen Psalmist of Israel, from the wrath of the Lamb!

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Dear Jason, I have indeed prayed for you, sir. Give me a moment of your time, what better thing do you have to do? Yet again as I am studying the Word of God this day, and seeking the King of Kings, He has put you on my heart, and I cannot but write you. He has not forgotten you yet, albeit if you continue in your course of willful sin, He will (in His time) utterly pass you by. How long does the Lord have to wait for you to cease defrauding Him of His own blood-bought possession, which is you, while you wallow in your own comparatively miniscule problems, that are directly related to your own adultery against Jesus Christ, which you will not admit to? Remember the true Proverb, "He that covereth his sins shall not prosper: but whoso confesseth and forsaketh them shall have mercy." (Proverbs 28:13)

Friend, will you listen to wisdom for a moment from the written Word of God, and a man that has obeyed it and will obey it unto the end, as you are supposed to!? I don't want you to be in hell friend, with Judas Iscariot, Ahithophel, Adolf Hitler, and such men. Are the Scriptures God's Word or not, my fallen brother?

Indeed, you had it right for all of those years when you believed them (the Scriptures), Jason, and fought a good fight, building your life around them and not the worldly wisdom of men! It seems to me that you were very isolated at that time, from the reports Mark has said, and had to stand alone... but help was on the way! God would not leave you alone. The Lord was raising up our Church, full of sold out Saints gathered from all over this land, that were just like you! Following the biblical Jesus Christ, Who loves righteousness and hates iniquity, doing justice and judgment, and rejoicing in the Holy Ghost, while reproofing the unfruitful works of false Christianity, with the high praises of God in our mouths. Yet, when the Lord led your accountability partner (on and off, it seems), Mark De Rouville, to come and be with us and gave you a good testimony of this persecuted yet not forsaken lampstand of Jesus Christ through him, you didn't believe him in your pride! It sounds like Balaam in Numbers 23, who would not believe his ass, being blinded by his ambition, pride, and sin. In response to Balaam smiting the dumb donkey, he said, "And the LORD opened the mouth of the ass, and she said unto Balaam, What have I done unto thee, that thou hast smitten me these three times? And Balaam said unto the ass, Because thou hast mocked me: I would there were a sword in mine hand, for now would I kill thee" (Numbers 22:28-29). Why did you smite Mark and William, Jason? Because you are fallen in the vomit of sin, my friend, and you have "forgotten that you were purged from your old sin" (2 Peter 1:9)!

"Then the LORD opened the eyes of Balaam, and he saw the angel of the LORD standing in the way, and his sword drawn in his hand: and he bowed down his head, and fell flat on his face. And the angel of the LORD said unto him, Wherefore hast thou smitten thine ass these three times? behold, I went out to withstand thee, because thy way is perverse before me: And the ass saw me, and turned from me these three times: unless she had turned from me, surely now also I had slain thee, and saved her alive. And Balaam said unto the angel of the LORD, I have sinned; for I knew not that thou stoodest in the way against me: now therefore, if it displease thee, I will get me back again. (Numbers 22:31-34)

Jason, presently, you are deceiving and being deceived friend! Mark de Rouville tells me that you used to preach to him and knew the Word better than he did. He is to this day astounded that he is going on with the Lord in the beauty of holiness, fleeing from the wrath to come, raising up his son in the fear of the Lord, laying down his life for the people of God, and you are turned coat against the King, fallen in the miry depravity sin to the utmost! He doesn't understand why the Lord spared him and not you. O may the Lord spare both of you, from the filthy vileness of iniquity and the abominable snares of Satan! Have you not read Hebrews 3 where it says, "Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief, in departing from the living God. But exhort one another daily, while it is called To day; lest any of you be HARDENED THROUGH THE DECEITFULNESS OF SIN. For we are made partakers of Christ, IF we hold the beginning of our confidence steadfast unto the end; While it is said, To day if ye will hear his voice, harden not your hearts, as in the provocation?" (Hebrews 3:12-15) I am sure you did read this passage in the past, sadly you didn't have it fulfilled in your life because you

hardly knew a true Christian, and had hardly a soul to exhort you! The Lord surely did condescend to you though, but when the opportunity came and you heard about our church, you fled without a cause, Jason! Choosing rather to turn to sin, and listen to the slander of men against the people of God in our land! (not all of them, but many, who have gathered from all over the country to learn to fear Him, and stay free from sin by the Gospel of his grace and the blood of the Lamb!) You will notice something that I have highlighted in the text above in Hebrews, "hardened through the deceitfulness of sin." You have forgotten what that means Jason! You have taken your armor off, and fled from the battle. Where are you my brother, you should be fighting the battles of the Lord like you once did, and iniquity would not be found in you. But you put off your war paint and in your heart began to faint! Faint not, Jason, the Lord will help you, if you will repent with such reckless abandon that men will tremble at you! If ever you needed to seek Him the time is not.

"I pray thee, forgive the trespass of thine handmaid: for the LORD will certainly make my lord a sure house; because my lord fighteth the battles of the LORD, and evil hath not been found in thee all thy days." (1 Samuel 25:28)

He will not prosper your adulterous relationship Jason! He is not frowning upon your worldly sorrow, murmuring and complaining about your troubles, when they are comparatively few in light of the Lord Jesus Christ's suffering for you! Who gave Himself for your sin, that He might redeem you from among men, and make all things new in your life! As the Lord broke King Jehoshaphat's ungodly works, when he wanted to make an alliance with wicked King Ahab and send ships to seek for the gold of Ophir, so He will break your wicked works too. This relationship of open adultery will never prosper, Jason! The Lord will not let it! You are crucifying your King afresh and putting Him to an open shame, repent my brother, and seek mercy by the virtue of His blood and name!

"And ye shall seek me, and find me, when ye shall search for me with all your heart." (Jeremiah 29:13)

Come to Wells, lets talk my brother! Don't be proud, but stop sinning against the Lord Jesus Christ and causing little one's for whom Christ died to stumble, as you excuse yourself because of you bitterness against the Lord, your wife, and whoever else.

I have 3 last things to say to you, dear Jason. First, I love you brother, and grieve for you from the depths of my soul.

Second, when I mentioned 1 Samuel 25:28 above, which were the words of the godly Abigail to David, I mentioned it in part to this end: David was free from sin, (I heard you use that term in your testimony, which you are shaming, that is still on YouTube), for Abigail said, "evil hath not been found in thee all thy day," and she makes a connection of his freedom from sin with his fighting the battles of the LORD! You used to fight the battles of the Lord. I have heard you talk about persecution in your music. Indeed, some of your anointed music of old was itself "fighting the battles of old", yet through the subtlety of the serpent and the cunning craftiness of men whereby they lied in wait to deceive you, you stopped fighting! Thus, as it was for David, iniquity was not far behind you! Now you are fallen and you need a resurrection, but don't fret only fear and repent, the Lord Jesus Christ is able to help you (If you would respond to me I would help you more, Jason! There are many resources I could send you, my fallen friend)!

As you right well know by 2 Samuel 11, David stopped fighting the battles of the Lord, as you have, and he began to enjoy the spoils of his Kingdom, settling down upon his lees and becoming Lukewarm, like you did! He was given to abundance of idleness, fullness of bread, and pride, which were the root sings of Sodom and Gomorrah (Eze. 16:49) before him and even a man after God's own heart, which sought God like almost no one else did, fell prey to the most severe of rebellion against His worthy Lord Jesus Christ, for around a year and a half of pure darkness - Adultery, deception, and murder included, not to name all of the rest of His Christ shaming sin! He was a sweet Psalmist of Israel, but he lost his sweet tune! Surely in David's flesh he was not better than Saul, but the Lord had mercy.

"And it came to pass, after the year was expired, at the time when kings go forth to battle, that David sent Joab, and his servants with him, and all Israel; and they destroyed the children of Ammon, and besieged Rabbah. But David tarried still at Jerusalem. And it came to pass in an eveningtide, that David arose from off his bed, and walked upon the roof of the king's house: and from the roof he saw a woman washing herself; and the woman was very beautiful to look upon." (2Sam. 11:1-2)

So were you a sweet Psalmist of Israel, Jason, and so have you lost your sweet words! Notwithstanding, when the Lord sent him Nathan the prophet to rebuke him in the name of the Lord, he repented in such fervent zeal, humility, humiliation, intensity, and holy passion for the Lord Jesus Christ, that all the powers of hell trembled and the Lord was with him again as never before, putting those sweet songs back in his mouth! O hallelujah for the mercy of the Lord.

If David would have died in darkness, he would have perished, and so will you, but David saw the shame of his folly when the Lord sent a lowly man of God to rebuke him and so should you! You have played the fool before your worthy Lord, Jason Bellard! You have made the righteous grieve and rejoiced the hearts of the wicked! Indeed, holy angels are appalled at you, but my dear brother, how long!? When will you put away your foolish and childish ways, and seek the Lord that you once knew? Manasseh sinned every bit as much as you and was taken captive to Babylon, yet he humbled himself greatly and put away all worldly sorrow, thus giving glory to God that put him in those chains for his sins in the first place, and the Lord did break his chains and lead captivity captive back to Jerusalem! So the Lord has made you chains in your apostasy from His worthy name, HUMBLE YOURSELF, you are in the chains of darkness and under the powers of devils, but appeal to the higher powers of Heaven, namely Jesus Christ, the name above every name in this world and in that world which is to come! He saved you once

from your sin, can He not save you again and get a testimony that will make the remnant in our land tremble and be heard around the world! Repent Jason, repent and quit seeking the pleasure of sin and the approval of men, my brother! "How can ye believe, which receive honour one of another, and seek not the honour that cometh from God only?" (John 5:44) "For do I now persuade men, or God? or do I seek to please men? for if I yet pleased men, I should not be the servant of Christ." (Gal. 1:10)

Lastly, I want to share with you this testimony that I read in Leonard Ravenhill's second book, "Revival Praying". He believed that a regenerate man could fall into darkness and be lost, and be received again. So do I! Scripturally it is called being "overtaken in a fault" (Gal. 6:1), or being held "in the snare of the devil" and being taken "captive by him" (2 Tim. 2:26). You are in such a case, my fallen friend, and I am "...in meekness instructing those that oppose themselves, if God peradventure will grant them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth" (2 Tim. 2:25).

Here is the testimony from Ravenhill's book! May it be yours, friend!

"Recently we were in meetings with a gospel team. During the Spirit-anointed time, a fine man returned to the Lord after years of wandering and failure. His recovery was full and complete, a miracle of grace. I think those present will not forget this brother's prayer for some time.
