Dearly Beloved Brethren in the Lord,

The past two days have been very hard for me. I endeavored to communicate the most complicated truths I have yet tried to do, and because of this...phrasing my sentences in such a way that are "translate-able" is very difficult. Communicated simple truths are much easier, though it is still hard to do, but this was extremely difficult for me. The first day (yesterday) went ok...The Lord was there in convincing power enough so that their mouths and confusion was put to rest (they were not argumentative in any unrighteous sense but they were very cautious, careful, and comprehensive in their considerations). They have been leavened for a LONG time...thus there was much to unravel. By God's glorious grace they were (generally speaking) convinced of their error, persuaded against eternal security, seeing its errors in the scripture, and the undeniable scriptures which affirm a man to fall from grace. After this day ended I was very discouraged, though I was keeping faith in God. I felt so incapacitated from pursuing them as I desire (in the Lord) because of the language barrier. I sent a text message for help and prayer, AND GOD ANSWERED!!!

Day two was much better than the former by God's glorious grace AS AN ANSWER TO YOUR PRAYERS! Oh brethren, rejoice with me! God came! He descended upon us in a measure of GRIPPING power. The doctrine moved from their heads to their hearts (generally speaking) - but especially with Alfonso! By God's grace through the supply of His Spirit, I was enabled to preach on perfection and worthiness as they pertain to the pastoral burden seen in scripture ("The Presentation" as it applies to falling from grace). With this as the main burden, I was able to make them aware of the vast absence of scriptural burden in their life (which affects prayer and preaching), and after establishing this I was able to preach upon the Judgment Seat of Christ in such a way which sobered them into silent astonishment (by God's glorious grace). After the preaching ended (which like yesterday lasted most of the day), the elders sat in silent astonishment and fear (Alfonso especially). We got on our knees and Alfonso began weeping, "I am afraid Lord!" "I am afraid for your Church!" "Help us to preach this to your people!" [paraphrased] etc... Alfonso got up and hugged me with the most sober and God-fearing hug I have received yet. Martin got up and honored me in the Lord with sincerity, sobriety, and fear, with thankfulness, for the first time since I have been here. Brethren, it was a mighty break through by the Lord! Praise the glory of His grace!!! Oh our Great King, how glorious are His goings bounding forth from the sanctuary! How beautiful are His footsteps! How captivating is His gaze! Honor and majesty are His! And we are the people of His footstool! Hallelujah!

Brethren, this break through of fear, sobriety, urgency, and intentional-ity is the greatest measure yet (on the main burden for which we came down here)! There is a terrible lightness that pervades the Church - a lack of eternal-mindedness, a lack of gravity, a lack of redemption of the time, a lack of personal devotion in prayer and study, a lack of being alone with God, a lack of depth in their fellowship, a general sliding into fruitless conversations which do not lead them into greater glories in Christ, and a lack of conviction to know any of this is even happening. You see brethren, they have been weeping and fearing at the messages thus far, yes, but they still are so terribly ignorant of how to be a Christian (in so many ways that you take for granted). It has never even occurred to them to do the things that you take for granted in Wells. There has been a need for great condescension and patience (at times I think I err to wait too long...God help me while I am absent from Ryan and Jake!). Oh brethren, there was a break through today! I am so grateful to our God! Oh praise Him with me brethren!

It appears that Martin is still backslidden... please pray for him. I am concerned for the state of Junior as well...but I could be over-worried for him. Eder seems to be the closest behind Alfonso (I could be wrong). And Alfonso is GETTING THE BURDEN! Oh praise God! Praise His name!

I have had two dreams warning me to be careful since I have been here (I thank God He is taking care of me in the absence of my beloved elders). The two dreams have been a warning:

1st Dream) Jesus Christ said, "To speak about the glory of God is one thing, but to live for the glory of God is another". 2nd Dream) Jesus Christ warned me, "be careful to examine the people to make sure they are doing the word which they are hearing".

The two dreams communicated the messages above (generally speaking), and I need great help to see to the accomplishment of these burdens. Please continue to keep us in your prayers. The devil prowls...but God has henceforth CLOSED HIS MOUTH, please pray that it shall ever be so! God is gracious brethren, and greatly to be feared in the assembly of the saints. I long to be back with you, to walk among those who are the more naturally of one mind, who are aware of the burdens of God in a work-able measure, that I might be clean escaped from all the beasts of leaven which I wrestle with day and night with agony and tears, groanings and sighs...but our God has sent us here to rescue lost sheep, to bring back his lost coins, to cause holy angels to rejoice, and to prepare for the battle of Dry Gultch - BLESSED BE HIS NAME!
