

Dearly beloved Brethren of the Lord Jesus in Wells and Alto Texas (primarily, but also to the edification of all the Australia Brethren whom we love and miss dearly),

Greetings to you all in the name of Jesus Christ our Savior!

I have a burden on my heart I am compelled to convey to you all early on in this week. I feel that I cannot forbear until Saturday or Sunday! It has to do with the vision and direction the Lord has been giving us lately. As you know, we have been praying and asking God to teach us how to be a Biblical Church that is completely Ruled by God – led and operated by God’s initiative in all our meetings. We have called this in time past, “the immediate sovereignty of God”. If you remember the video of Leonard Ravenhill, it was devoted to the same burden. In short, my burden in this email is simply -- I believe we need to be **a people who follows The Cloud of God’s presence!** Let me explain.

Sunday evening at the Charity Feast, the glory of God fell upon us (I am sad for those who left early and did not get to witness this glorious outpouring of the Holy Ghost)! It was exceedingly glorious! When the psalmists (Jake & Dan) picked up the minstrels I felt the Spirit of God fall upon us in the room we were in! I could scarcely keep the tears from flowing out of my eyes as I was preaching to Kalani. This is not necessarily unusual for me, but, mind you, the tears were coming for no reason at all except that the Presence of God was falling upon us in the room! Apart from any conscious thought, I was just trying to hold-up and keep from weeping because of the weight of glory which was being shed abroad in the room! Do you remember the scripture, “the priests could not stand to minister by reason of The Cloud: for the glory of the LORD had filled the House of God” (2 Chron. 5:14)!

Brother Jake and Ryan, also, including Cory, and I am sure a multitude of others, do also attest to the outpouring of the Spirit of God at this time. Jake said, *“Ryan and I were utterly agreed that when the song began the Holy Ghost fell! Ryan said, in holiness, that it was as though he was immediately intoxicated by the Holy Ghost, and I wholeheartedly agreed! I was endeavoring to keep quiet, and was only playing in the back of the room because I couldn't find a place in the isles, so I thought if I played in the back till Dan was able to join then I wouldn't disturb anybody... that's when Elijah came up to me and asked if he could sing with me, so I turned to "Leaning On Jesus" and began to play softly to him and I, when all of a sudden I heard loud shouts of praise coming from behind me, and instantaneously was FILLED with the Holy Ghost! Truly, brother, it was as though I was in another world!.. It was REMARKABLE!”*

Furthermore, dear Brethren, as the night went on and the hearts and mouths joined in greater and greater unity (“in one accord”), it felt as though the Presence of God was exploding in the room. I was full of holy dread, wonder, worship, adoration, peace, and joy! I went toward the center of the room to get some keys from a bother (the center around which the Brethren were gathered, generally speaking), and I felt the glory of God shining with such heat and strength, I almost wanted to shield my eyes! Oh brethren, this is exactly what we have been preaching about when we have been speaking about *spontaneous worship, prophetic worship, spontaneous prayer*, all following the leadership of the LORD. Now brethren, we need to understand God’s ways as they will relate to the new Church House that is almost completed.

I believe that when the Church House is finished, it will be a place that draws the hearts of those who want to pray or praise, each heart expecting to find fellow pilgrims already there in the sanctuary with burning-souls, ready-hearts, holy-hands, and lips that are full of matter, and then, suddenly, as gatherings happen, prayers and praise will ignite, and God will send more brethren, and it will just increase and climax! As the prayer meetings will ignite and flame upward, as time will cease, I believe most if not all of the Church will be drawn to the meeting with hunger and anticipation, and, thus, events like this will happen many times throughout the week! This being the case, I believe texts will go out notifying the Church that the glory of God has fallen upon the brethren in the Church House, and then whoever wants to come would come and join! Thus, the meetings will begin and end as the LORD leads, and texts go out as notification. Each heart will be drawn because **The Cloud** is there, and each heart will not want to leave because **The Cloud** is there! Each heart will not want to stop until **The Cloud** departs! Yes, then to go and do whatever God would be leading according to His glorious purpose! Thus, we, being full of expectation, will be full of the Holy Ghost and power! I believe the Church House will become a place of 7-days-a-week Christianity, where we become a people that follow **The Cloud** and not a people who make schedules. I believe that God will come so exceedingly that prayer meetings will happen all throughout the week, so much so that, Lord willing, we

will never have to schedule a prayer meeting again because of the outpouring of the Spirit and the leadership of God Almighty in our midst (except on extraordinary circumstances, generally speaking)! Then, glory to God! We would no longer be a people of schedules or man-made mechanisms, no! But a people who follow **The Cloud** of God's presence and glory! I believe this is where the LORD is taking us, dear brethren! Do you remember the scripture, "And **all the people saw The Cloudy Pillar stand** at the tabernacle door: and **all the people rose up and worshipped**, every man in his tent door" (Ex. 33:10). Glory to God! Hallelujah!

Also, shockingly, the LORD was moving upon the children in a profound way! Jake gave testimony, saying, "*It was amazing, brother, how for hours the children were enthralled by the Spirit through the singing (not without intermittent reproofs and instruction), even in the end, Savanna was raising her hands with sobriety and loud singing! She was sitting next to me the whole time and singing along, fearing my words, helping me see the hymnal, etc. Truly, it was powerful! I've never had so much faith for her. After this all ended, we prayed in mighty power and she was very sobered during that time, still considering the things that had just happened (p.s. Dan said that she is typically VERY shy and would never do such a thing)... I believe the Lord was speaking something too about the children...*"

In the light of this, dear Brethren, please be aware and be expectant for the Lord! The Lord of Hosts is ready to descend upon us in New Testament glory and power! Hallelujah! Amen and Amen. Glory be to His Name and glory be to the Son of God! Praise Him!
