

**In the summary to his video posted January 29, 2018 (since removed from YouTube), Reece Ringnald wrote the following:**

To all the victims of my brother and the Church of Wells, including victims of Sean Morris, I want to extend my deepest, and most heartfelt apology. My brother was a good man and the best brother a brother could ask for prior to his exposure to a fringe religious group during his time in University. Whatever harm he or his Church may or may not have caused you, it has cost me a brother and afflicted me more than you could ever imagine. I am estranged from my brother. Any views - whatsoever - that you may find from him, do not represent my views in any way, shape, form, or fashion.

If you have any thoughts, inclinations, or are curious about how to contact/join the Church of Wells: PLEASE RECONSIDER. I would be happy to tell you about how painful my estrangement to him was, or about all the people he has hurt. I am a practicing Christian man. This video is not intended as slander or liable against Christianity, only against those who use the teachings of Christianity to hurt others, especially the ones that love them. Christ did not command you to estrange yourself from your family. And Christ would never teach you to behave or speak to others the way that the Church of Wells does. If you are struggling with your faith because a loved one or friend has taken any religion's teachings and perverted them to a ludicrous and dangerous extreme, please understand that no proper religious or spiritual system should ever teach you to live isolated and hateful. My brother is wrong. And the Church of Wells is wrong.

Christianity is a loving and evangelical faith which teaches tolerance, tradition, and growth. God has the final word; however, here is my word: I am ashamed that my own brother has perverted my faith the way he does. I am not telling you to believe, not believe, what faith to follow, or how to live your life. Live according to an ethical, morally defensible, and good manner. Do not shun others, proselytize the unwilling, or convince your followers to leave their families and loved ones. Such commands can only be the work of evil.

If any of you have any family members, loved ones, or are yourself considering leaving your family for any religious, philosophical, or spiritual belief system, please reconsider. There are hundreds of registered sects & cults in the United States. Each one demands familial estrangement and complete devotion. Many victims of abuse and neglect turn to persuasive and charismatic figures for relief, not realizing the serious danger they are in. Brainwashing - or mind programming - is more of a danger than many of you may have ever imagined. People on the autistic spectrum, clinical depression, psychosis, delusions, and other mental disorders are especially vulnerable to mind programming.

PLEASE take notice if your loved one's personality, voice intonation, or "eye glaze" has significantly and abruptly changed. These are often signs of potential brainwashing. Please use my example and Catherine Grove's example as unwilling victims, suffering because we either didn't notice the signs sooner or took action soon enough. Watch who your son, daughter, husband, or wife spends time with, especially if they spend a considerable amount of time with common signs of psychopathy/sociopath behavior, and ESPECIALLY if your loved one is in a vulnerable place in his/her life or might be on the special needs spectrum.
